


<< it's a lovely sunny day the work continues underway

A different view now seen, from presbytery view, amazing is such a sight, long we have so waited but it'll be worth it that is right!




Slightly different angle, so much to be seen Blessed be those builders for working like a dream!

A roof in place at last we see, amazing work for all to see>>>>


